HOSPICE APPROACH TO DEMENTIA CARE

Prepare person/family about what to expect in advanced stage

- ✓ Start early
- ✓ Talk about what is to come
- ✓ Identify treatment preferences before complications occur
- ✓ Establish directives in writing
- ✓ Structured guides/materials help
- ✓ Hospice approach: Dementia specific discussion
- ✓ Physician Order of Life-Sustaining Treatment (POLST)

Hospice Approach to Dementia Care

- ✓ First <u>palliative care model</u> for advanced dementia (Note: the term "palliative" was not used at the time the model was first developed)
- ✓ Goal is to find a balance between prolong life and preventing suffering as dementia progresses
- ✓ Focus on promoting comfort & quality of life
- ✓ Approach: Family discussions about care that focus on the person's value and beliefs
- ✓ Discuss intervention options/choices AND risks and benefits to person
- ✓ Review choices each care planning meeting
- ✓ The Hospice Approach blends palliative care with hospice
- ✓ Both target treating pain and discomfort and focus on quality of life, not length of life
